JOINT STATUS REPORT

The plaintiffs are preparing an amended pleading, which will seek to add some additional plaintiffs to the case and remove the claims that are now foreclosed by the Supreme Court's ruling in *Kennedy v. Braidwood Management Inc.*, 606 U.S. 748 (2025). The plaintiffs' lawyers are vetting the additional plaintiffs who wish to join the lawsuit to ensure that they have Article III standing to pursue the claims that remain open after the Supreme Court's decision. The plaintiffs' lawyers are also waiting for decisions from other potential plaintiffs who have expressed interest in joining the lawsuit but have not yet decided whether to join the amended pleading.

The plaintiffs will share their amended pleading with the defendants' counsel when the drafting is complete and request their consent to file, but the parties expect that the defendants will withhold their consent and require the plaintiffs to move for leave of court over the defendants' opposition. The plaintiffs expect to have the proposed amended pleading drafted and the motion for leave to amend filed by the end of the calendar year.
