JOINT STATUS REPORT

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Pursuant to the Court’s order of September 12, 2024, ECF 65, the parties respectfully submit this Joint Status Report.

TMA III and LifeNet III

On August 24, 2023, the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Texas granted in part and denied in part the parties’ cross-motions for summary judgment in *Texas Medical Association v. U.S. Department of Health and Human Services*, No. 22-cv-450 (E.D. Tex.) (lead case) (“*TMA III*”), and *LifeNet, Inc. v. U.S. Department of Health and Human Services*, No. 22-cv-453 (E.D. Tex.) (“*LifeNet III*”). On October 30, 2024, the Fifth Circuit reversed portions of the district court’s ruling and affirmed others. *Tex. Med. Ass’n v. U.S. Dep’t of Health & Human Servs.*, No. 23-40605, --- F.4th ---, 2024 WL 4615744 (5th Cir. Oct. 30, 2024). As relevant here, the Fifth Circuit upheld the portions of the rule that Plaintiffs challenge in this case. The time to seek further review of the Fifth Circuit’s decision has not expired.

In light of the status of this related litigation, Plaintiffs request that the stay in this matter should remain in place, and Defendants do not oppose that request.
