

ORDER granting 98 Motion to Extend the Scheduling Order. Non-expert depositions will begin on May 16, 2023, and conclude by August 9, 2023. Plaintiff shall designate all trial experts and provide their reports to Defendants by September 8, 2023. Defendants shall designate all trial experts and provide their reports to Plaintiff by November 15, 2023. Plaintiff's reply expert reports must be provided to Defendants by January 9, 2024. Depositions of all experts must be completed by February 8, 2024. Discovery must be completed by February 8, 2024. Dispositive motions must be filed by March 12, 2024. In addition, the parties shall submit a joint status report informing the Court as to the status of document discovery by February 17, 2023. If there are any live discovery disputes at that time, such as those referenced in the motion for extension of time, the parties shall identify such disputes in the status report.
