## **ORDER**

The parties have filed a Joint Motion for a Stay of Proceedings. [DE 138.]

Following my opinion and order dated August 12, 2021 [DE 137], the only remaining claim in this case is an arbitrary and capricious challenge to the Final Rules. The Federal Defendants have moved for summary judgment on this issue. [DE 114.] The parties now jointly move to stay the case because on August 16, 2021, the Federal Defendants "announced that they intend to initiate a rulemaking regarding the contraceptive coverage requirement within 6 months." [DE 138 at 2.] The parties agree that staying the case pending the agencies' rulemaking would conserve the resources of the Court and the parties, and I concur.

Therefore, the Joint Motion for a Stay of Proceedings [DE 138] is GRANTED and it is ORDERED that the case is STAYED. The Federal Defendants shall file a status
