Exhibit B: *C.P. by and through Pritchard v. Blue Cross Blue Shield of Illinois*, No. 3:20-cv-06145-RJB, 2023 WL 8777349, at *3 (W.D. Wash. Dec. 19, 2023), *appeal filed* No. 23-4331 (9th Cir.) is a memorandum opinion and order granting the plaintiffs' motion for classwide declaratory and injunctive relief and for nominal damages.
