Considering the unopposed motion<sup>1</sup> to consolidate the above-captioned matter with Civil Action No. 23-1305 filed by defendants, HCA Healthcare Inc. and Louisiana Children's Medical Center,

**IT IS ORDERED** that the motion is **GRANTED**. Civil Action No. 23-1305 is consolidated with the above-captioned matter. All pleadings hereafter filed in this consolidated proceeding shall bear the caption of the lead consolidated case together with the docket number of all cases within the consolidation to which the document applies or the notation "ALL CASES" if it applies to all cases.

All entries shall be made on the master docket sheet only, with a notation listing the cases to which the document applies, except that orders and documents terminating a party or disposing of a case will also be entered on the individual docket sheet. All documents shall be filed in the master file only, except that orders and documents terminating a party or disposing of a case will also be filed in the record of the individual case.
