**PLAINTIFFS' NOTICE OF MOTION TO EXPEDITE
AND FOR A TEMPORARY ADMINISTRATIVE STAY**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Plaintiffs Novo Nordisk Inc. and Novo Nordisk Pharma, Inc. (together, "Novo") respectfully move for a temporary administrative stay and to expedite the Court's consideration of this matter. More specifically, Novo requests that the Court (1) enter a temporary administrative stay to enforce its previous order granting the parties' agreed-upon briefing schedule and to preserve the Court's ability to resolve the merits of this case, (2) set a date for a hearing as soon as possible after Novo submits its final reply brief on July 6, 2021, and (3) expedite its ruling on the parties' dispositive motions.
