FILE TEMPORARILY UNDER SEAL**



Producing entities shall have fourteen days from the date of this Order to file a motion to seal any portion of those documents.

It is **FURTHER ORDERED** that any response in opposition to any motion to seal is due fourteen days after the filing of the motion.
