Second Amended Scheduling Order

This scheduling order restates, amends, and supersedes the Court's First Amended Scheduling Order, ECF No. 173.

- a) Initial disclosures were due on or before May 13, 2024.
- b) Discovery otherwise began on or after May 13, 2024.
- c) The parties agreed on the handling of electronically stored information, privileged information and a privilege log, if necessary.
- d) The parties agreed to limitations as it relates to interrogatories, admissions, productions.
- e) The parties substantially completed document productions in response to each side's May requests for production by December 16, 2024.
- f) Fact discovery closes May 30, 2025.
- g) The party bearing a burden on an issue must designate its expert and provide the expert's initial report on or before July 25, 2025. A party may designate a rebuttal expert and provide a report solely to contradict or rebut an initial report

on or before by September 19, 2025. A party's expert may reply to a rebuttal report on or before October 31, 2025. By submitting a report on or before July 25, 2025, the party does not concede it bears the burden on an issue. Expert discovery closes November 21, 2025.

- Expedited responses are required on all pretrial motions. h)
- Discovery may be extended by agreement of the parties without Court i) intervention so long as the dispositive motion deadline and docket call dates are not changed without leave of Court.
- Dispositive motions must be filed on or before January 5, 2026; responses are due j) February 19, 2026; replies are due March 23, 2026. No sur-replies are permitted.
- Docket call is set April 6, 2026 k) at 11:30 a.m.
