ORDER

The court’s order entered on March 8, 2024 (Dkt. No. 68), required the parties to confer about redacting certain exhibits to the parties’ pleadings and to notify the court of a proposed agreement on the redactions no later than thirty days after entry of the order. The order also specified that the documents would remain under seal until further order of the court. The parties jointly submitted their proposed redactions to the court on April 8, 2024, via email. The court finds that the proposed redactions properly redact the sensitive information regarding the substance of the government’s ongoing investigation that the court identified in its memorandum opinion (Dkt. No. 67) as warranting redaction.

Accordingly, the court ORDERS the Clerk to enter the unsealed, redacted versions of the following documents:

- e. Dkt. No. 19-11, Exhibit 10 (regarding interrogatories)
- f. Dkt. No. 19-13, Exhibit 12 (regarding negotiations and specific areas of questioning for witnesses)

The Clerk shall send a copy of this order to all counsel of record.
