**CONSENT ORDER EXTENDING
TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER**

Rule 65(b)(2) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure provides that temporary restraining orders “expire[] at the time after entry—not to exceed 14 days—that the court sets, unless before that time the court, for good cause, extends it for a like period or the adverse party consents to a longer extension.” Fed. R. Civ. P. 65(b)(2). All Defendants and Intervenor-Defendants have consented and agreed to the extension of the temporary restraining order entered in this case until such time as the Court rules either on Plaintiffs’ motion for a preliminary injunction, Doc. 11, or on a renewed motion for a preliminary injunction that Plaintiffs will file by a date to be set by the Court.

It is therefore **ORDERED** that the temporary restraining order entered by the Court, ECF No. 31, is **EXTENDED** and shall **REMAIN** in effect until such time as the Court

rules on either Plaintiffs' motion for a preliminary injunction, Doc. 11, or on a renewed motion for a preliminary injunction that Plaintiffs will file by a date to be set by the Court.
