ORAL ORDER denying Motion for Extension of Time to File Response/Reply. The court's scheduling order allowed the parties three months to prepare a joint appendix and defendants six weeks to file a reply brief to plaintiffs' opposition to defendants' motion for summary judgment. ECF No. 72. Those times are more than sufficient to accommodate defendants' asserted need to familiarize themselves with the issues. The motion does not show that defendants cannot meet the deadlines and, thus, does not show good cause to warrant additional time for filing a reply brief or the joint appendix.
