JOINT STATUS REPORT

Pursuant to the Court’s February 18, 2026 Order accepting the Parties’ Joint Proposed Jurisdictional Discovery Plan (See ECF Nos. 86, 87), Mylan Pharmaceuticals Inc., Mylan Specialty L.P., and Mylan Inc. (collectively, “Plaintiffs”) and Defendants Sanofi S.A., Sanofi-Aventis U.S. LLC, Aventis Pharma S.A., and Sanofi-Aventis Puerto Rico Inc. (collectively, “Defendants”) (together with Plaintiffs, the “Parties”), hereby submit this joint statement regarding the status of the issue of the application of the Hague Convention on the Taking of Evidence Abroad in Civil or Commercial Matters (the “Hague Convention”) to this action and the Parties’ efforts to finalize a proposed protective order for the Court’s approval as follows:

1. The Parties’ Joint Proposed Jurisdictional Discovery Plan set forth the Parties’ agreement to provide the Court with a further joint submission regarding the status of meet and confer efforts on the issue of the Hague Convention’s applicability to this action and to file a proposed protective order for the Court’s approval by no later than February 27, 2026. ECF No. 86, ¶¶ 3-4.

2. Defendants' counsel provided Sanofi S.A. and Aventis Pharma S.A.'s written position regarding the application of the Hague Convention to Plaintiffs' First Set of Jurisdictional Discovery Requests for Production to Sanofi S.A. and Aventis Pharma S.A. on February 18, 2026.

3. Counsel for the parties met and conferred regarding the application of the Hague Convention on February 24, 2026.

4. On February 24, 2026, Plaintiffs' counsel emailed a draft of a proposed protective order governing discovery for Defendants' review.

5. Defendants' counsel sent proposed edits to the draft protective order to Plaintiffs' counsel on February 25, 2026.

6. Counsel for the Parties held a further meet and confer regarding the application of the Hague Convention to discovery in this matter and the draft protective order on February 26, 2026. The Parties agreed that additional discussion on both of these topics may result in a mutually agreeable resolution that avoids the need for Court intervention.

7. The Parties agree to file by no later than March 16, 2026, a further joint submission setting forth the Parties' further position regarding the application of the Hague Convention. If the Parties remain at an impasse, they will contact the Court to request a telephone status conference.

8. The Parties jointly agree that the deadline to file a proposed protective order for the Court's approval should be extended from February 27, 2026 to March 19, 2026.

9. All other deadlines in the parties' Joint Proposed Jurisdictional Discovery Plan (ECF No. 86) shall remain unchanged.
