**THIS MATTER** having been brought before the Court upon Plaintiffs Teva Branded Pharmaceutical Products R&D, Inc., Norton (Waterford) Ltd., and Teva Pharmaceuticals USA, Inc.'s (collectively, "Teva" or "Plaintiffs") Motion to Stay the Court's June 10, 2024 Order (D.E. 88) pending the resolution of Teva's appeal, or in the alternative, a 30-day stay to permit resolution of Teva's application to the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit for a stay pending appeal; and the Court having

considered the papers and arguments of the parties; and for good cause having been shown:

**IT IS** on this 13th day of June, 2024;

**ORDERED**, for the reasons set forth on the record on June 13, 2024, that Plaintiffs' alternative request in its Motion for a 30-day stay to permit resolution of an application to the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit for a stay pending appeal is **GRANTED**; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the Court's June 10, 2024 injunction Order (D.E. 88) is hereby **STAYED** for a period of 30 days from today's date (which period, under Fed. R. Civ. P. 6(a)(1)(C), shall expire at 11:59 p.m. EDT on July 15, 2024); and it is further

**ORDERED** that the parties shall meet and confer and propose to the Federal Circuit a briefing schedule for Teva's application for a stay and a briefing schedule for the appeal.
