- The Secretary has primary regulatory and enforcement authority for Title I of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act ("ERISA"), 29 U.S.C. § 1001 et seq.
- 2. On June 12, 2024, the Secretary filed an amicus brief in support of Plaintiff-Appellant addressing whether Plaintiff-Appellant adequately pleads that a third-party administrator that overpaid claims with funds remitted by an ERISA plan is a fiduciary under 29 U.S.C. § 1002(21)(A)(i).
