GOVERNMENT'S NOTICE OF A RESUMPTION OF APPROPRIATIONS

On November 12, 2025, the Continuing Appropriations, Agriculture, Legislative Branch, Military Construction and Veterans Affairs, and Extensions Act, 2026 was signed by the President. That law restored appropriations to *inter alia* the Department of Justice, effective November 13, 2025. In light of that development, Defendants intend to meet and confer with Plaintiffs regarding next steps in this case, and the parties will file a joint status report with the Court within 14 days.
