STATUS REPORT

Plaintiffs respectfully submit this status report to inform the Court of recent factual developments relevant to the Court's consideration of the pending Motion to Dismiss (ECF No. 33) and schedule for further proceedings.

On July 15, 2026, the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ) issued form notices to approximately 150 grantees, informing them that AHRQ had denied their long-pending requests for continuation awards. In light of this factual development, and after reviewing the relevant law, Plaintiffs plan to request that this Court grant them leave to amend the complaint to add allegations and claims related to this recent agency action. Given the pending motion to dismiss, Plaintiffs submit this update to inform the Court of this planned request to amend, which may be relevant to the Court's determination of the pending motion to dismiss.

Plaintiffs plan to file their motion for leave to amend the complaint on or before August 21, 2026. On Friday August 14, Plaintiffs informed Defendants about the forthcoming motion and requested their position. Defendants have not yet provided any position on the motion.
