PLAINTIFFS' REQUEST FOR JUDICIAL NOTICE

Plaintiffs ACA International and Fresno Credit Bureau d/b/a Creditors Bureau USA
(collectively, "Plaintiffs"), by and through their undersigned counsel, request the Court to take
judicial notice of the following publicly-available Facebook post by Defendant Attorney General
Philip Weiser related to his 2026 campaign for Colorado Governor. In support of the motion,
Plaintiffs state as follows:

1. The post is publicly available at the following link:

2. The post is a video with audio of Defendant Attorney General discussing the statutes directly
at issue in the instant matter, HB 23-1126 and C.R.S. § 5-18-109(1)(f)(I), and is relevant to the
arguments advanced by Defendants in the Motion to Dismiss in Part the Second Amended

Complaint filed by Defendants Fulford, Administrator of Colorado’s Uniform Consumer Credit Code, and Colorado Attorney General Weiser, Dkt. 38 at 10 (“[T]here is no evidence the Attorney General has ever used his CCPA powers to enforce the CCRA’s limitations on medical debt reporting or has plans to do so in the future.”)

3. The post makes the following printed statement, also shown in the screenshot immediately following:

Keeping medical debt on credit reports hurts families already struggling with unexpected bills. It’s outrageous — and it’s cruel. I’ve taken on predatory medical debt practices before, and I won’t stop now. #copolitics #philforcolorado #medicaldebt See less



4. The post originates from Defendant Attorney General's Colorado Governor campaign

5. Below is a true and accurate transcription of the Facebook post audio spoken by Attorney

General Weiser:

Right now, the biggest form of debt in America is medical debt. People who have an emergency procedure all of a sudden can be out thousands, tens of thousands, hundreds of thousands of dollars and it can happen with surprise bills. It's not fair. That's why I fought for legislation in Colorado. Medical debt can't be placed on your credit record and you can't be subject to debt collection if it's a surprise bill or you're otherwise contesting it. Right now, the Trump administration is trying to take away these protections. We'll fight for these protections. I'll always fight for Colorado.

6. Judicial notice is appropriate because the post is generally known within the trial court's territorial jurisdiction and can be accurately and readily determined from sources whose accuracy cannot reasonably be questioned. The post originates from Defendant's own Facebook account and clearly depicts the Attorney General's image and voice. Attorney General Weiser is, in fact, the Democratic candidate for Colorado governor as of the date of this notice.
