**ORDER**

Defendants have filed an Unopposed Motion for Leave to File Documents Under Seal [Doc. 25] requesting leave to file under seal “their Brief in Support of the Motion to Compel Arbitration, or Alternatively to Dismiss the Complaint for Lack of Personal Jurisdiction and Failure to State a Claim, and redacted copies of the confidential agreements and amendments between UHIC and Ballad Health and its affiliates, which are quoted at length throughout that brief.” In support, Defendants claim that the documents contain confidential information and include terms “which preclude or limit public disclosure of their content.” [Doc. 25, p. 1]. Defendants further assert they intend to seek entry of a Protective Order, or that the parties will jointly tender an Agreed Protective Order setting out the process to deal with confidential information. Plaintiffs do not oppose this motion.

The Court finds the Motion [Doc. 25] filed by Plaintiff to be well-taken and it is **GRANTED**. The Clerk is directed to file the Proposed Sealed Documents [Doc. 26] under seal.
