ORDER

Plaintiffs have filed an Unopposed Motion for Leave to File Document Under Seal [Doc. 30] requesting leave to file under seal “their Memorandum in Opposition to Defendants’ Motion to Compel Arbitration, or Alternatively to Dismiss the Complaint, which quotes and discusses at length confidential agreements and amendments previously filed under seal in this action.” In support, Plaintiffs claim that the memorandum contains confidential and proprietary information and includes terms “that preclude or limit public disclosure of their contents.” [Doc. 30, p. 1-2]. Plaintiffs advise that they anticipate the parties will seek entry of a protective order addressing confidential and proprietary information or will jointly tender an agreed protective order setting forth a process for handling such materials. Plaintiffs attached to their Motion a redacted version of their Memorandum in Opposition which the Court has reviewed and found to contain reasonable redactions. Additionally, Defendants do not oppose the Motion.

The Court finds the Motion [Doc. 30] filed by Plaintiff to be well-taken and it is **GRANTED**. The Clerk is directed to file the Proposed Sealed Document [Doc. 31] under seal.
