Dear Judge Koeltl:

Pursuant to Local Civil Rule 7.1(e) and Individual Rule I.C, Plaintiffs in the above-referenced action submit this letter to request a 30-day extension of time to file their brief in opposition to Defendants' motion to dismiss, which was filed on April 3, 2026. *See* ECF No. 29. This is Plaintiffs' first request for an extension of this deadline.

Plaintiffs' opposition is currently due on April 24, 2026, and Plaintiffs request an extension to May 26, 2026. Co-lead counsel for Plaintiffs, Sara Mark, is currently on maternity leave until May 1, 2026, and Plaintiffs' other counsel are managing heavy workloads in other pending cases, including important deadlines within the next several weeks. As a result, Plaintiffs' counsel anticipates needing additional time to prepare the opposition. In addition, the Court has referred the parties to mediation before Judge Netburn, which has not yet been scheduled, but which the parties agree should occur as soon as reasonably possible. Plaintiffs' counsel, therefore, anticipates that preparation for the mediation will likely overlap with their preparation of the opposition brief, further necessitating a modest extension of time.

Defendants' counsel consents to the relief requested herein.
