MINUTE entry before the Honorable John F. Kness: Telephonic status hearing held on 4/9/2026 concerning the pending motions filed by both sides. See *Nelson v. Napolitano*, 657 F.3d 586, 587 (7th Cir. 2011) (Rule 41(a)(1)(A) notice of dismissal "is self-executing and effective without further action from the court").
