**DEFENDANT CHRISTOPHER COOPRIDER'S ANSWER
TO PLAINTIFF'S FIRST AMENDED COMPLAINT**

Defendant Christopher Coopriders files this Answer to Plaintiff's First Amended Complaint, and in support thereof, would respectfully show the following:

1. On August 24, 2026, the Court granted (Dkt. No. 119) Plaintiff's Motion for Leave to Amend (Dkt. No. 108) and instructed the Clerk of Court to file Plaintiff's First Amended Complaint, which was ultimately entered as a corrected amended complaint (Dkt. No. 123). The amended complaint added two separately named entities related to the alleged medication provider defendants and new claims for relief against the various medication provider defendants—but admittedly made no changes to the allegations or claims against Defendant Coopriders. *See* Pl's Mtn for Leave (Dkt. No. 108) at 2.

2. Accordingly, in response to Plaintiff's First Amended Complaint, Defendant Coopriders relies upon, refers back, and incorporates as if fully set forth herein his original answer (Dkt. No. 7). For clarity and the Court's convenience, Defendant Coopriders notes that due to the amended complaint's numbering changes, the paragraph references in his specific Rule 8(b)(1)(B)

responses to Plaintiff's allegations on pages 75-89 of his original answer should be considered revised as follows:

a. Paragraphs 7-11 of the First Amended Complaint were added/revised from the Original Complaint. They are all directed towards and relate to other defendants, and Defendant Cooprider is without sufficient information to admit or deny the allegations in paragraphs 7-11 and as a result denies the same.

b. Paragraphs 12-89 of the First Amended Complaint are unchanged from the Original Complaint's paragraphs 8-85, with the amended paragraphs all now numbered exactly 4 numerals higher each. Defendant Cooprider relies upon, refers back, and incorporates as if fully set forth herein his original answers to those allegations with the appropriate numerical changes.

c. Paragraphs 90-94 of the First Amended Complaint were added from the Original Complaint. They are all directed towards and relate to other defendants, and Defendant Cooprider is without sufficient information to admit or deny the allegations in paragraphs 90-94 and as a result denies the same.

d. Paragraph 95 of the First Amended Complaint was revised from the Original Complaint to add claims for relief against the medication provider defendants. Defendant Cooprider continues to deny that he is legally responsible "to pay nominal, compensatory, and punitive damages for the wrongful death of Ms. Davis's unborn child," nor to pay for any "other relief that the Court may deem just, proper, or equitable."
