

MINUTE ORDER (Text Only Entry) issued by Courtroom Deputy for District Judge Dale A. Drozd on 3/27/2026: On 3/26/2026, plaintiff filed a 135 motion to stay purportedly pursuant to Local Rule 233. Local Rule 233 permits motions for administrative relief such as "requests to alter a discovery schedule that does not affect dispositive motion filing dates, trial dates, or the final pre-trial conference." L.R. 233. Plaintiff's motion seeks a stay until thirty (30) days after a ruling on a pending motion in a related case in the Northern District of California. Accordingly, plaintiff's motion seeks an alteration of the discovery schedule that will affect dispositive motion filing dates, trial dates, and the final pre-trial conference and cannot be brought pursuant to Local Rule 233. Therefore, the court DENIES plaintiff's 135 motion without prejudice to its refiling pursuant to Local Rule 230. (Deputy Clerk PAB) (Entered: 03/27/2026)
