

TEXT ORDER: Before the Court is Plaintiffs' Motion to Enforce Order Granting Preliminary Stay and Preliminary Injunction. ECF No. 83. The Court has reviewed and carefully considered the motion, the exhibits attached thereto, and the defendants' response in opposition (ECF No. 84). The Plaintiffs' Motion is DENIED. As the defendants acknowledge, the NOFO for the CoC Competition and Youth Homeless Demonstration Program Grants (ECF No. 84-1 at 96) clearly indicates that any future grant agreements and terms will comply with the preliminary injunction terms currently in place (see ECF No. 77). As it stands, Plaintiffs may respond to the NOFO with an application without being required to agree to, or implement, the enjoined conditions. Defendant HUD shall provide clarification to Plaintiffs by Wednesday, December 10 that the NOFO conditions at the heart of Plaintiffs' Motion to Enforce will not be enforced so long as the October 23, 2025 Preliminary Injunction Order remains in full force and effect.
