

ORDER. Currently pending before the Court are stipulations of dismissal based on a settlement involving Kaiser, the government, and/or Relators. About the time the stipulations of dismissal were filed, a third party (Mr. Mazik) filed a notice, asserting a right to a share of the settlement proceeds. If Mr. Mazik believes he is entitled to a share, he must file a motion for relief and set it for hearing before the Court; he cannot simply rest on his notice. Any such motion shall be filed by February 4, 2026. The Court assumes that neither Mr. Mazik nor any party is claiming that the settlement is no longer valid in light of Mr. Mazik's claim -- i.e., the dispute here is simply how the settlement proceeds should be distributed. Mr. Mazik and the parties should promptly meet and confer to confirm that this understanding is correct. Signed by Judge Edward M. Chen on 1/21/2026.
