ORDER

At issue is Plaintiff United Healthcare Services Inc.’s Motion to Seal Unredacted Complaint (Doc. 9).

In the Ninth Circuit, courts “start with a strong presumption in favor of access to court records.” *Ctr. for Auto Safety v. Chrysler Grp., LLC*, 809 F.3d 1092, 1096 (9th Cir. 2016) (quoting *Foltz v. State Farm Mut. Auto. Ins. Co.*, 331 F.3d 1122, 1135 (9th Cir. 2003)). “In order to overcome this strong presumption, a party seeking to seal a judicial record must articulate justifications for sealing that outweigh the historical right of access and the public policies favoring disclosure.” *Kamakana v. City & Cty. of Honolulu*, 447 F.3d 1172, 1178–79 (9th Cir. 2006). Where a document is “more than tangentially related to the merits” of a case, the party seeking to seal the document must demonstrate “compelling reasons to keep the documents under seal.” *Ctr. for Auto Safety*, 809 F.3d at 1103.


Undoubtedly, Plaintiff’s Complaint is more than tangentially related to the merits of this matter, and Plaintiff must thus demonstrate compelling reasons to justify keeping

1 the unredacted Complaint under seal. In the Motion, Plaintiff satisfactorily shows
2 compelling reasons for sealing the designated information because it is comprised of
3 Plaintiff's confidential and sensitive rate information. Moreover, Plaintiff has filed a
4 redacted version of the Complaint on the public docket. (Doc. 1.) Accordingly, the Court
5 will grant the Motion.

6 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** granting Plaintiff United Healthcare Services
7 Inc.'s Motion to Seal Unredacted Complaint (Doc. 9).

8 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** directing the Clerk of Court to file under seal the
9 document currently lodged under seal at Doc. 10.
