

ORDER GRANTING IN PART and DENYING IN PART 24 Joint Motion for Extension and Proposed Briefing Schedule. Defendants waived service of the 1 Complaint on 6/10/2026. Thus, pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(a), Defendants current deadline to respond to the 1 Complaint is 8/4/2026. Now, in the 24 Joint Motion, the parties move for an extension of that deadline until 8/25/2026, averring that such extension is necessary in light of the complexity of the issues presented in the 1 Complaint. The parties also propose a briefing schedule for the motion to dismiss that Defendants intend to file in response to the Complaint. The Court finds that good cause exists for the requested extension. However, the Court will not set a briefing schedule for Defendants forthcoming motion to dismiss, because the briefing schedule for dispositive motions is set forth in this Courts practices and procedures (available at: https://www.pawd.uscourts.gov/sites/pawd/files/Wiegand_Practices_Procedures_2024.pdf). Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the 24 Joint Motion is GRANTED IN PART and Defendants shall respond to the 1 Complaint on or before 8/25/2026.
