ORDER

Before the Court is the Parties' Stipulation Governing Proceedings (Dkt. 15). Finding good cause, the Court **ADOPTS** the Stipulation and orders the following:

- a. Defendant will respond to Plaintiff's motion for a preliminary injunction on or before **Monday, June 29, 2026**.
- b. Plaintiff will file any reply brief in support of its motion for a preliminary injunction on or before **Monday, July 13, 2026**.
- c. Defendant's obligation to answer or otherwise respond to the complaint (or any amended complaint) will be stayed, and such answer or other response will not be due until **21 days** after the Court fully resolves Plaintiff's motion for a preliminary injunction.
