ORDER

Before the Court is Defendants' opposed motion for an extension of time to respond to Plaintiffs' motion for summary judgment (Docket No. 44) and for leave to file excess pages. Docket No. 52. Specifically, Defendants seek a 21-day extension to respond to Plaintiffs' motion for summary judgment and request a 10-page extension for a combined response and cross-motion. *Id.* at 3. Plaintiffs oppose both requests.

The Court **GRANTS-in-part** Defendants' motion (Docket No. 52). Specifically, the Court **GRANTS** a 7-day extension for Defendants to file a response to Plaintiffs' motion for summary judgment. Defendants' response in opposition to Plaintiffs' motion for summary judgment, and any cross-motion, is now due **August 29, 2025**. The Court additionally **GRANTS** Defendants leave to file ten excess pages for a combined response and cross-motion.
