**STATUS REPORT**

Pursuant to this Court’s May 26, 2026, Order, the government respectfully submits the following status report.

1. This case concerns the pre-merger reporting requirements governing certain large transactions. *See* 15 U.S.C. § 18a(d). In 2024, the Federal Trade Commission published a final rule updating those reporting requirements. *See Premerger Notification; Reporting and Waiting Period Requirements*, 89 Fed. Reg. 89,216 (Nov. 12, 2024). After plaintiffs challenged the rule, the district court entered summary judgment in their favor and vacated the rule.

Soon after the Commission appealed, it published a request for information that sought “public comment on the effectiveness of the Hart-Scott-Rodino Antitrust Improvements Act (‘HSR Act’)’s premerger reporting requirement.” FTC, *Request for Public Comment Regarding Making Improvements to the Premerger Notification and Report Form*,

The Commission explained that “[r]egardless of the outcome” of this appeal, “the Commission is considering engaging in a new rulemaking process.” *Id.* On the government’s motion, this Court placed the appeal in abeyance through December 31, 2026, and directed the government to file status reports every 60 days.

2. The public comment period for the RFI closed on May 26, 2026. The Commission received 55 responsive comments. The Commission is currently evaluating those comments as it determines whether to proceed with a rulemaking.

3. The government will continue to update the Court with status reports at least every 60 days.
