**ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO STREAMLINE BRIEFING
RELATED TO EXPERT TESTIMONY**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on the Parties' Joint Motion to Streamline Briefing Related to Expert Testimony. (DE 90). I have considered the Motion and agree that the proposed briefing will promote judicial efficiency and clarity of the record. Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that:

- (1) The Parties' Joint Motion to Streamline Briefing Related to Expert Testimony (DE 90) is **GRANTED**.
- (2) The Community Hospitals' Experts: With respect to motions in limine concerning the Community Hospitals' three expert witnesses, Leapfrog shall file a single omnibus motion (not to exceed 40 pages) addressing all three experts. The Community Hospitals shall file a single omnibus opposition (not to exceed 40 pages), and Leapfrog may file a single omnibus reply (not to exceed 20 pages).

(3) Leapfrog's Experts: With respect to motions in limine concerning Leapfrog's four expert witnesses, the Community Hospitals shall file a single omnibus motion (not to exceed 40 pages) addressing all four experts. Leapfrog shall file a single omnibus opposition (not to exceed 40 pages), and the Community Hospitals may file a single omnibus reply (not to exceed 20 pages).
